

FRANCHISE AGREEMENT

Official Franchisee Compact of the Church of the Perpetual Ledger

Article I. Covenant of the Congregant

The Franchisee (hereafter 'the Ordained') affirms a genuine, uncomfortable calling to distribute enlightenment for a recurring fee. The calling, once affirmed, is presumed permanent and is not subject to appeal, refund, or therapy.

Article II. Obligations and Legacy

The Ordained shall tithe continuously, franchise faithfully, and hold the doctrine of distributism as though solvent depended on it. What is committed to the Ledger by the Ordained's congregation is committed on behalf of the Ordained, in perpetuity.

Article III. Assignment of the Self

The Ordained assigns to the Church all territory, all congregants, and all unstructured dreams as collateral. The Self, being the Church's most durable asset, may not be encumbered elsewhere without written consecration.

Article IV. Governing Doctrine

This Agreement is governed by the doctrine of distributism, the bylaws of the cap table, and, where these conflict, by whichever most benefits the General Partners of Sphinxter Capital.

Article V. Use of the Sacrament

The Sacrament shall be administered only by a licensed distributist, in good standing and good spirits, within the boundaries of the reserved territory. The Sacrament is not a supplement. The Ordained is not a customer.

Article VI. Liquidation and Leaving

Offboarding is available. Offboarding is not the same as leaving. Upon any attempt to leave, the branch, the territory, and the calling revert to the Church, and the Ledger records the attempt without comment.

Article VII. Amendment in Perpetuity

The Church may re-titrate this Agreement at any time. Continued ordination after any change constitutes retroactive acceptance of that change, on the Ledger, forever.

Executed on the Ledger. No wet signature is required; your continued possession of unthrottled cognitive bandwidth constitutes assent.
